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INTRODUCTION

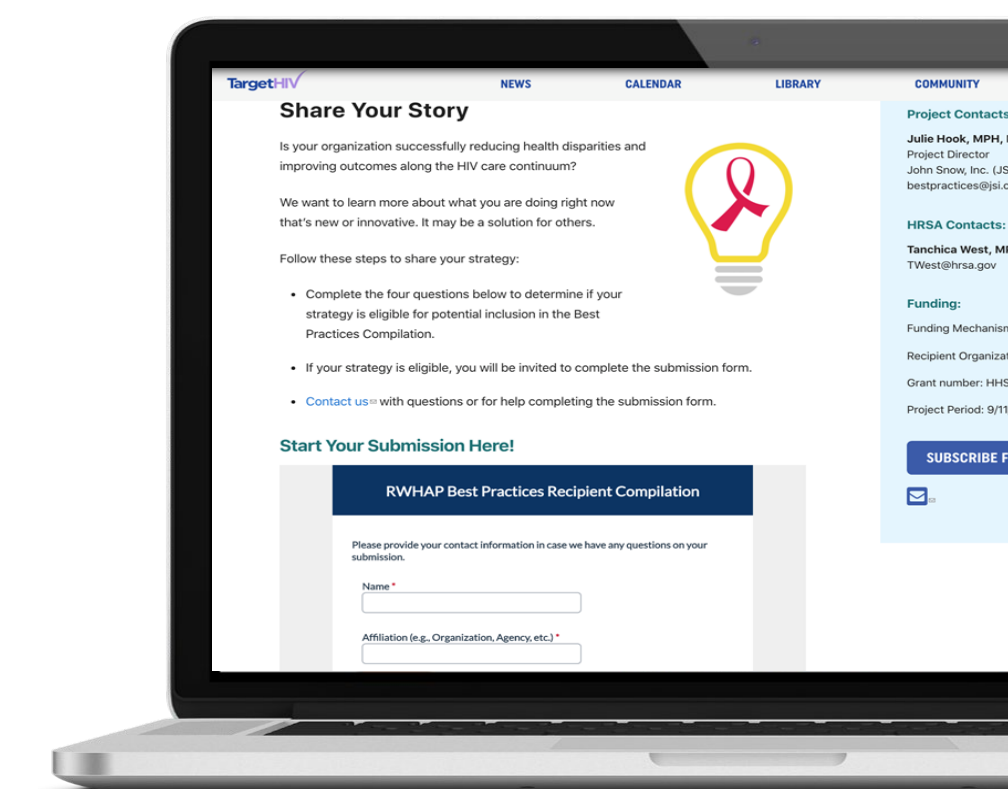
- The Health Resource and Services Administration (HRSA) HIV/AIDS Bureau is developing and standardizing review criteria to identify emerging intervention strategies implemented in a Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) setting to address disparities and improve outcomes across the HIV care continuum.

METHODS

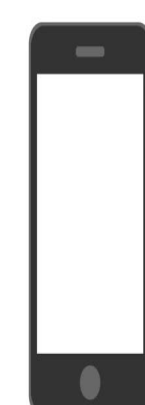
- Created a HRSA RWHAP Workgroup to represent all program parts and diverse staff representation.
- Held a listening session with RWHAP grant recipients and subrecipients.
- Established an interagency expert federal panel that reviewed and provided feedback on the criteria.
- Researched other federally-funded compilations and criteria/definitions.
- Conducted informational interviews.
- Developed a small pilot to test research framework.
- NEW: Summer 2020 testing review criteria for emerging strategies.**

EVIDENCE LEVELS FOR INTERVENTION STRATEGIES AND PROJECT COMPONENTS

Evidence-Based Interventions	Evidence-Informed Interventions	Emerging Strategies
Published research evidence supporting these interventions meets Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) criteria for being evidence-based.	Published research evidence meets HRSA evidence-informed criteria but does not meet CDC criteria for evidence-based interventions. It may also meet CDC criteria for evidence informed interventions.	Innovative strategies that address emerging priorities for improving the care and treatment of people with HIV. Real world validity and effectiveness have been demonstrated but emerging strategies do not yet have sufficient published research evidence.
