
#### INTRODUCTION

The Health Resource and Services
 Administration (HRSA) HIV/AIDS
 Bureau is developing and
 standardizing review criteria to
 identify emerging intervention
 strategies implemented in a Ryan
 White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP)
 setting to address disparities and
 improve outcomes across the HIV
 care continuum.

## **METHODS**


- 1. Created a HRSA RWHAP Workgroup to represent all program parts and diverse staff representation.
- 2. Held a listening session with RWHAP grant recipients and subrecipients.
- 3. Established an interagency expert federal panel that reviewed and provided feedback on the criteria.
- 4. Researched other federally-funded compilations and criteria/definitions.
- 5. Conducted informational interviews.
- 6. Developed a small pilot to test research framework.
- 7. NEW: Summer 2020 testing review criteria for emerging strategies.





Stakeholder input leads to a new Emerging Strategies Review Criteria to systematically capture HRSA HAB Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program implemented best practices.
